

What is a Commercial Driver License?

A commercial driver license (CDL) is a special driver's license that is required to operate certain types of commercial motor vehicles (CMVs). CMVs are defined as vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 26,001 pounds or more, or any single vehicle with a GVWR of 10,001

pounds or more that is designed to transport 16 or more passengers, including the driver.

There are different types of CDLs, each of which allows the holder to operate different types of CMVs. The most common types of CDLs are:

- **Class A CDL:** This type of CDL allows the holder to operate any single vehicle with a GVWR of 26,001 pounds or more, or any such vehicle that is designed to transport 16 or more passengers, including the driver.
- **Class B CDL:** This type of CDL allows the holder to operate any single vehicle with a GVWR of 26,001 pounds or more, or any such vehicle that is designed to transport 16 or more passengers, including the driver, but does not include vehicles that require a Class A CDL.
- **Class C CDL:** This type of CDL allows the holder to operate any single vehicle with a GVWR of 26,001 pounds or more, or any such vehicle that is designed to transport 16 or more passengers, including the driver, but does not include vehicles that require a Class A or Class B CDL.

What are the Requirements for Getting a Commercial Driver License?

In order to obtain a CDL, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old (21 years old for interstate commerce)
- Have a valid driver's license
- Pass a written knowledge test
- Pass a skills test

- Pass a medical exam

How to Study for the Commercial Driver License Test

The best way to prepare for the CDL test is to study the official CDL manual. The manual covers everything you need to know to pass the test, including information on:

- Commercial motor vehicle safety
- Vehicle operation
- Road signs and signals
- Hazardous materials
- Air brakes
- Combination vehicles

questions correctly in order to pass. The skills test will be conducted in a CMV and will evaluate your ability to perform the following maneuvers:


- Pre-trip inspection

- Coupling and uncoupling a trailer
- Backing up
- Driving in traffic


