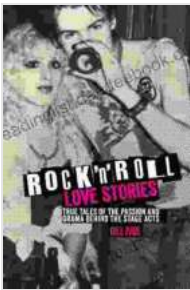


Rock 'n' Roll Love Stories: Legendary Couples Who Rocked the World

Jack White and Karen Elson



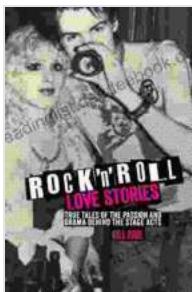
