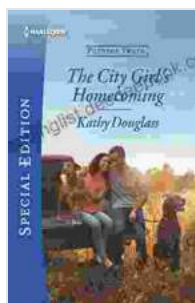


# The City Girl's Homecoming: Furever Yours

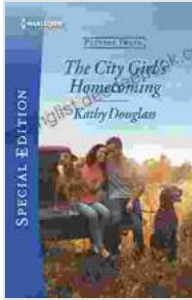
